Who May Enter

Entries of horse-drawn wagons, buggies, chuck wagons, etc., and people riding horseback, are encouraged. Automobiles, and other floats are permitted.

Parade Rules

- All horseback riders must be in proper attire (long pants and hard-toed boots).
- Parade and/or event officials have the right to eliminate any entry.
- Entries may hand out or carefully throw candy.
- Entries with children under the age of 18 must include at least one responsible adult.
- Parade route is approximately 1 mile long.
- The parade route crosses three bridges over running water. Please be sure your horse(s) are comfortable with that.
- Parade line up (order) is at the discretion of parade officials.
- Parade entries will not be judged, and prize money will not be awarded.
