Subject: Hyattville Old Timer's seek Vendors for Street Fair & Farmer's Market on July 25th

Hyattville, Wyoming – The Hyattville Old Timer's Committee is seeking vendors for the Street Fair and Farmer's Market during the 100th Annual Hyattville Old Timer's Day on July 25th. The celebration is in conjunction with the National Day of the American Cowboy (NDAC), sponsored by Guardians of the Range.

The Street Fair and Farmer's Market begins at 2pm in downtown Hyattville, and vendors will be assigned spaces along the sides of Main Street in downtown Hyattville. Registration is \$5 a space. Booth space is filling up quickly, and pre-registration is recommended by July 18. Vendors should bring display equipment, including necessary tables, stands, chairs, etc., and shade. Electricity is not available.

Vendors marketing books, hand crafted items, western art, jewelry, garden produce, jams & jellies, etc. are encouraged to attend. Committee Co-Chair, Julie Greer says "The local Paintrock Punchers 4-H Club serves food downtown during the afternoon and evening as a fundraiser, so we are looking for anything but 'meal' vendors. However, snacks, cotton candy, kettle corn, or ice cream would be great."

The Street Fair and Farmer's Market is part of a fabulous lineup of events beginning with the Old Timer's Picnic at noon in the Group Shelter at the Medicine Lodge State Archaeological Site. At 2pm, the free family fun continues in downtown Hyattville with kids games and events, critter rides, silent auction, log branding, raffles, and live entertainment. Evening events include a worn-out cowboy boot contest, awards ceremony, and street dance with music by the Cowley Boys.

The Hyattville Old Timer's Association, Guardians of the Range, and the Ten Sleep – Hyattville Lion's Club are sponsoring the day's events.
